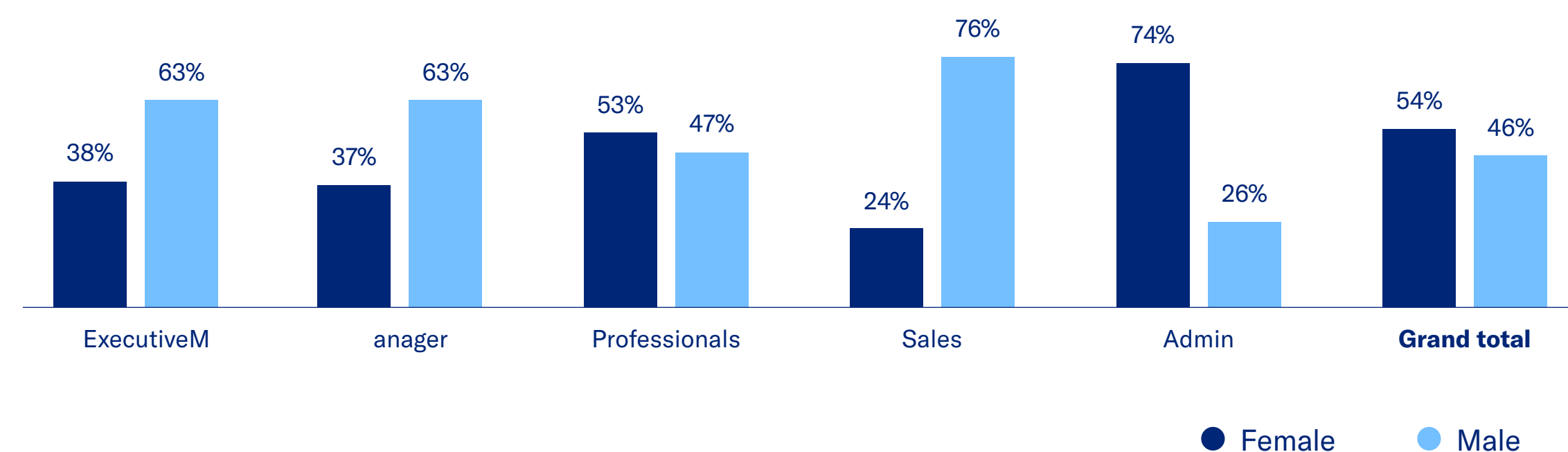


# Equitable EEO-1 supplemental diversity data
